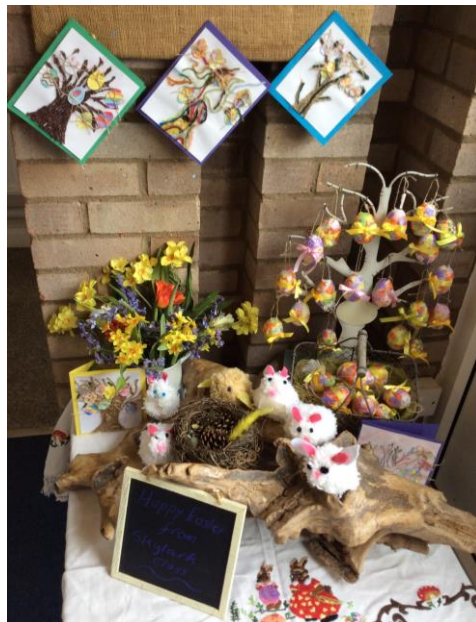
*This is our school

Start of the School Day

We have decided to modify the arrangements for the start of the school day, with the changes coming into effect on the first day back after the Easter holiday.

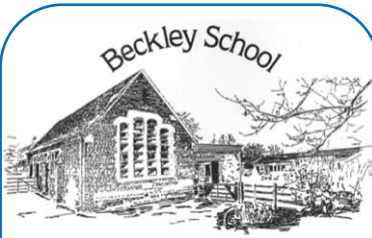
The side gate will be opened by a member of teaching staff at 8.40am as normal. This staff member will be on duty to receive the pupils until 8.55am.

Parents are welcome to accompany their children to the main playground, where they can wait with them and are able to visit the school office if required. A second member of staff will be out in the playground from 8.40am so that parents who wish to drop their children off and go, can do so. At 8.55am the school bell will ring and the children will line up in their classes to enter school, being led in by their respective class teachers. Parents are asked to remain outside.

Parents can then leave through the side gate, which will be locked at 9.00am. Late children will need to be buzzed in through the front gate and report to the office to be signed in.

On particularly wet days, children will be directed straight to their classrooms by the member of staff on the gate.

We are making these alterations to promote independence in our children and to ensure that we fully meet our health and safety and safeguarding responsibilities in providing a safe and secure environment for children, employees and visitors to the school.



Beckley School **After School Club**

Our popular After School Club runs from 3.20pm until 5.30pm every school day.

It provides high quality childcare with a wide range of fun activities and play opportunities for the children.

The club is run by the school and conforms to all of our policies and procedures.

Any child who comes to the school is welcome to attend the club.

Places are restricted for the children's own safety and to ensure adequate staffing.

It costs £7.00 per child per session.

Pupils must be booked into After School Club termly in advance.

Junior Citizens

Earlier this week Year 6 took part in the highly acclaimed Junior Citizens programme, helping pupils know how to keep safe in everyday life. This involved a series of role play scenarios, such as making 999 calls on a mobile. The children were encouraged to make decisions which they may face during a real life emergency.
