Mr Speller is a CEOP-trained Ambassador, a 360 Degree SAFE Assessor and his sessions on Online Safety have been well-received in a number of Oxfordshire schools.

The session will cover the following:


- Identification of the risks of using the internet including; loss of personal data, 'nude selfies'
- Viruses, online predators etc.
- Online Bullying, the truth
- Rules and tips to keep your young person safe online
- Talking to your young person about Online Safety
- Places to go for further help and support
- Things you can do to keep your young person safer at home
- Your chance to ask questions
